In summer, Manresa reserves four blocks of time for individual retreats, with the opportunity to meet one-on-one with a Jesuit or trained lay person. The experience can help you slow down, become more aware of God's love and presence in your life, and help deepen a loving relationship with God. There's a special atmosphere in the house when people come together for a shared purpose, growing closer to the Lord and to one another in silent, prayerful communion. "In-session" dates allow for eight-day retreats as well as retreats of shorter duration (four-day minimum within session dates/times). Arrival time begins at 5:00 PM on the opening date of the retreat session, dinner is at 6:00 PM and the retreat itself begins at 7:30 PM. The retreat ends at 10:00 AM on the closing date of the retreat session. Alternately, individuals may choose "out-of-session" dates for individually directed retreats between September and April each year.
