A message from the Executive Director



Dear Friends of Manresa,

At the beginning of 2024, I shared with you that Manresa would be involved in a Mission Awareness Examen, a type of evaluation initiated by our Midwest Jesuit Province this year. Many people have contributed their insights, ideas and wisdom in past months, including staff, board members, retreatants, graduates of our internship program and others who care about Manresa and its Mission.

In the report I collated from their input, some of Manresa's strengths and areas of concern are named and ways to move forward with the challenges Manresa faces are suggested. In further discussions, we hope to discern how to prioritize new ideas that have been proposed.

We are now drawing near to the conclusion of this process. Jordan Skarr, USA Midwest Provincial Assistant for Pastoral Ministries, and five others representing five Jesuit retreat houses or ministries in the US will visit Manresa October 28-30. They will study the report, meet with various groups involved in Manresa and make recommendations.

I continue to ask your prayers for this important moment in Manresa's history, that we may become more effective in this Mission that is vital to our world: to help men and women grow spiritually through prayer, reflection, guidance and teaching according to the Ignatian tradition.
