A message from the Executive Director

Dear Friends of Manresa.

Often I experience moments of abundant grace through persons who come to Manresa for a retreat or program. The first weekend of March provided moments I will not forget.

We were beginning a healing retreat, and the power went off as soon as the Friday evening presentation ended and people were heading to bed. We offered flashlights to those who wanted them and then reported the outage.

Power was still off early Saturday morning and no estimated time of restoration was available. I spoke with one of the retreat directors who said one person had flown in from another state. I knew some people had come from the other side of Michigan and roads were not in good condition for driving. For these and other reasons, we decided the retreat would continue. I told the retreatants during breakfast, and added that we would leave a sign-out sheet on the entrance table for those who needed to go home. One person said: "But aren't we supposed to sacrifice during a retreat?" and others chimed in with a similar point of view. By Saturday evening, only four persons had gone home of the 20 attending.

Since then, I've read the evaluations and also some emails we received from attendees. Their willingness to find God in all things really touches me. Several retreatants said the power outage was a blessing, that they liked the serenity and simplicity. One said it changed the dynamics in a good way! I happily meditate on all I've learned from these retreatants.

Sunday, April 16 2:00-7:00 PM including dinner



A Day to Call Your Own





Individually Directed Retreats



In summer, we reserve four sessions for individual retreats, with the opportunity to meet one-on-one with a Jesuit or trained lay person. The experience can help you slow down, become more aware of God's love and presence in your life, and help deepen a loving relationship with God. There's a special atmosphere in the house when people come together for a shared purpose, growing closer to the Lord and to one another in silent, prayerful communion.

Each of the four sessions allows individuals to schedule a four- to eight-day retreat within session dates/times (a minimum of four 24-hour periods is required). Arrive no earlier than 5:00 PM on the opening date of your session. Dinner is at 6:00 PM, followed by a welcome and introductions at 7:30 PM. Each session ends by 10:00 AM on the final day. 
