



Fr. Bob Ytsen, SJ celebrates 50 years of ministry

Congratulations to Fr. Bob Ytsen, SJ




who marked his 50th anniversary as a Jesuit on September 2.

Fr. Bob entered the Society of Jesus at the

former Loyola House in Berkley, MI. He was ordained on June 12, 1982, at Madonna Della Strada, Loyola University, and made his final vows in December 1996.

He has spent most of his apostolic career in secondary education, having taught English at high schools in the Chicago Province, and now at U-D High School, Detroit. On staff at Manresa since 2014, Fr. Bob celebrates Masses, directs retreats and offers spiritual direction. We are grateful for his ministry here.





The Spiritual Exercises, developed by St. Ignatius of Loyola, offer a way to grow in prayer; to develop a real and personal relationship with God; to see more clearly God's presence in creation, your personal life story and current life circumstances; and to know Jesus more intimately, love Him more deeply and follow Him more closely.

At Manresa we offer several ways of praying and reflecting on the meditations and themes of the Spiritual Exercises in the midst of your daily life. Each experience requires a significant commitment of time for daily prayer on specific Scripture selections and weekly meetings with a director. *An offering of \$25 per session is appropriate.*

Choose the format that works best for you:

- Eight Weeks Pray daily for 30 minutes for eight weeks using retreat content offered online.
- 12 Weeks Pray daily for 30 to 45 minutes for 12 weeks using a prayer workbook/journal with daily Scripture and reflections.
- 9 30 Days Pray daily for 30 to 45 minutes aided by 30 sequential reflections for prayer and meditation available in a book or online.
- Ten Months (19th Annotation Retreat) A daily commitment of 60 to 90 minutes of prayer and reflection centered on the themes of the Exercises for approximately nine or ten months.

In addition to praying with the materials, home retreatants meet weekly with a spiritual director via Zoom, Facetime, phone or in person. Retreatants are also responsible for the cost of materials as required.

In the Ignatian tradition, praying with the imagination is called contemplation. In the Spiritual Exercises of Ignatius of Loyola, contemplation is an active way of praying that engages the mind and heart and stirs up our thoughts and emotions.
